


COVID-19 THERAPUETICS FOR OUTPATIENTS

*Patients at High Risk of Severe Disease

- 65 years or older
- Overweight or obese (BMI > 25)
- Pregnancy
- Chronic kidney disease
- Diabetes
- Immunocompromised
- Cardiovascular Disease
- Chronic lung disease
- Sickle cell disease
- Neurodevelopmental disorders
- Medical device dependence

**Patients w/ Moderate to Severe Immunocompromise

- Active treatment for solid tumor/hematologic malignancies
- Solid-organ transplant and on immunosuppressive therapy
- Receipt of (CAR)-T-cell or stem cell transplant (w/in 2 yrs of transplant or on immunosuppressive therapy)
- Moderate or severe primary immunodeficiency
- Advanced or untreated HIV infection
- Active treatment with high-dose steroids, alkylating agents, antimetabolites, immunosuppressive drugs, chemotherapy, tumor-necrosis (TNF) blockers, and other biologic agents
